



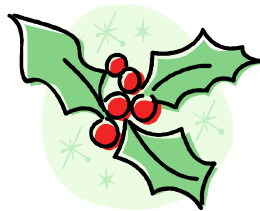

Intermediate and Advanced (6 weeks).....\$48.00

Starting: Tuesday, January 12th 6:30pm – 9:00pm

Our First Project will be: Feathered Star Snowflake

This class is for students who have quilted before and have chain pieced and cut fabric using a rotary cutter.

First in a series of classes for machine quilting - We will get you set up with the right equipment and learn straight line quilting using a walking foot. You will actually quilt a project of your own in class!

Log Cabin Crib or Lap.....\$35.00

A great first time quilt – Simple strip sewing makes this a fun quilt. If you have never made a quilt before, I recommend a crib size so you can learn to tie and put on a binding as well as piece the top.

Irish Mist\$35.00
 Saturday, January 23, 2010 9:30am – 3:30pm

We had so many quilters on our waiting list that we are repeating this class right away. I really like this quilt because the set up is so unique. Simple star blocks surrounded by an easy border medallion give this quilt the WOW factor!

Machine Quilting II\$25.00

You must have taken Introduction to Machine Quilting or have prior machine quilting experience. This class will concentrate on “free motion” quilting.

Feathered Snowflake - 24” square.....\$35.00
 Saturday, January 30, 2010 9:30am – 3:30pm

Dazzling! This difficult looking 15” block will impress everyone. You use strips of fabric and a paper piecing method that gives you perfect points. Great class whether or not you have ever paper pieced before. *Not recommended for first time quilters.*

Wedding Ring Table Runner.....\$35.00

I have taught several methods of Wedding Rings but sooner or later you had to piece curves, which are difficult. Finally, a great system that uses simple paper piecing enabling you to take out all the curves - Amazing! *All Levels*

Machine Quilting III.....\$25.00

This class continues where Machine Quilting II ends. You will be learning appliqué and decorative stitches. You need to have taken Machine Quilting I and II or have had prior machine quilting experience with another instructor.

This beautiful quilt was designed by Sarah Maxwell and Dolores Smith using fabric designed by Judy Rothermel.
